How do the adults at school keep you safe while you are in school? Can you give examples?	<p>If someone is hurt or bullied, they can tell someone on duty and they will help to make it right.</p> <p>The adults show you right from wrong</p> <p>The staff look after you when you are hurt</p> <p>They check the worry boxes to see if anyone needs help</p> <p>They teach us lessons like how to cross a road</p> <p>We do work on bullying prevention</p> <p>We have lessons about how to keep safe online</p> <p>They make sure we do not get lost and close the gates</p> <p>No Outsiders lessons such as treating people kindly and everyone is different</p>
What do you know about staying safe online? What have you learned in school to help you with this?	<p>I know no to share a picture of someone or myself if I am in school uniform</p> <p>You should never share your password</p> <p>You need to tell an adult if you have a problem or see something you don’t like</p> <p>Don’t play online games with people you do not know in real life</p> <p>You can have fake news and get scammed – once I was told I had won an ASDA voucher</p> <p>Don’t talk to people you don’t know</p> <p>Some games and videos have age limits that you should not watch or play until you are old enough</p> <p>You should always be kind online – do not bully online</p>
What have you learned about how to stay safe while you are NOT in school? Can you give examples?	<p>Road safety and how to cross a road safely</p> <p>Stay with you mums and dads to be safe when you are outside</p> <p>Do not talk or go off with strangers</p> <p>The police came to school and talked to us about being safe at Bonfire and Halloween</p>
What could you do if you notice something/someone in school that you think is not safe?	<p>You tell an adult in school and they will help you</p>
Do you feel safe at school	<p>All children present said they did</p>
If there anywhere you think that could be safer? What else could school do?	<p>The carpark when the cars are moving</p> <p>The quiet area – some children can be silly and do gymnastics</p> <p>The ball pen – you can get hit with a ball</p> <p>Some adults say to ignore someone when they are being unkind but that doesn’t always solve the problem</p>
