 - xii. Visits from PSCO on Bonfire and Halloween safety
 - xiii. Worry Boxes and can tell out teachers
- c. This year Safety Ambassadors will be working on
 - i. Bullying Prevention
 - ii. Online Safety
 - iii. Personal Safety
 - iv. Safety around school
 - v. Mental Health and wellbeing

2. Classroom environment surveys

- a. All ambassadors completed their surveys
- b. Ambassadors and teachers to make sure that they put up displays etc that are missing



3. Children's Voice about Safety in School

- a. All the children who are Safety Ambassadors said they felt safe at school

Action for Ambassadors for next meeting

- Share minutes from meeting and survey findings
- Remind all children about telling an adult if they have a problem and using the worry/feelings boxes if you don't feel you can say in person
- Make sure that any gaps in your classroom survey have been completed by your teachers. If you need something on your walls e.g. Childline – ask the teachers to put it up
