**Learning Outcomes**

**Listening**

- Listen attentively and show understanding by joining in and responding
- Link the spelling, sound and meaning of words

**Speaking**

- Engage in conversations; ask and answer questions; express opinions and respond to those of others
- Speak in sentences
- Describe people, places, things and actions orally (to a range of audiences)

**Reading**

- To adapt phrases to talk and write about the sports they know how to do
- To use the infinitive of jouer and faire when talking about sports they know how to do (Je sais jouer/Je sais faire)
- Identify and use adverbs of time/frequency
- To write and adapt sentences to describe the frequency of sports they do
- To extend their knowledge of pronouns in French
- To conjugate the verb faire and recognise the verb endings for each pronoun
- To use the command form of verbs to give simple instructions
